The Distance Between Us - Important Quotations

After you finish reading each chapter in the novel, you are going to do three things.

- 1) Give the chapter a name that sums up the main point of the chapter. What happens that moves the story forward? This can be a line or part of a line from the story. Explain why this is a good name for the chapter.

- 2) Pick a line or lines from the chapter that you think are most important. This quotation(s) should be the most important sentence in the chapter and should have something to do with the overall issues or problems the character is facing. Make sure you put the quotation in quotation marks and include the page number.

- 3) Explain WHY you chose that quotation. How does it relate to the character's struggle, her relationships, her lessons, her goals, etc.

EVIDENCE: Most important quote(s) from the chapter	REASONING: Why did you choose this quote? Why do you think it's important to the overall topics/plot in the book?
